The PSPH<sup>LMU</sup> was officially installed at the end of 2009 by the president of the LMU as a LMU working group.



## Scientific paradigm of PSPH<sup>LMU</sup>



The PSPH<sup>LMU</sup> approach to public health research perceives individual health as a reaction of the subject to his/her interaction with a complex surrounding system.

It makes public health research a systems science based on input from molecular biomedicine, clinical medicine, epidemiology, mathematics, social, as well as economic, managerial, communication, and political sciences.

The partners of the PSPH develop research projects and teaching programs which bring this idea to life.


